We are thrilled to share that the Mt. Holiday Sk & Snowboard Scholarship Program is now open to receive applications for the upcoming 2023-24 ski season. This initiative was established to assist families who face financial constraints in providing winter recreational activities for their children. As in previous years, we require all scholarship applicants to demonstrate their financial need through appropriate documentation (such as a Medicaid card, Bridge card, miHealth card, or participation in the school's reduced lunch program).

In the spirit of fostering community involvement, we also ask each scholarship recipient to commit a minimum of 10 volunteer hours at Mt. Holiday. With a range of age-appropriate volunteer opportunities available, we are confident in finding suitable roles for everyone. Furthermore, we invite each child (not their parent or guardian) to write a letter or create a short video sharing why Mt. Holiday holds significance to them and outlining their desire for a season pass. This personal touch helps us better understand the impact of our hill on their lives.

Our dedicated staff and Board of Directors are firmly dedicated to our community's growth and well-being. To ensure the inclusivity of all children, funds have been specifically allocated for this limited scholarship program. Our genuine aim is to ensure that no child misses out on the joys of fun, camaraderie, and personal growth due to financial constraints.
